Lesson 6

A helpful tool that you can use when thinking and planning your persuasive writing is to use the OREO writing tool.

This allows you to think of your writing as though it is an oreo biscuit.

The two biscuits are what we need to hold our thoughts together and the creamy goodness in the middle is the good stuff! without it you would just be eating dry biscuits! BORING!

Today you are going to try and use this writing tool to help you with your persuasive writing.



**O: Opinion**

**State your opinion about the topic**

**R: Reasons**

**Give reasons or information to support your opinion**

**E: Examples**

**Give details and examples to support your reasons**

**O: Opinion**

**Restate your opinion with emotion**

Now it's your turn to give it a try

On the next slide you can click and add the details - this is just the planning page so you do not need to go into lots of information. You will use a sentence or dot points for this.

Once you have created your plan you will then use your **online literacy** book to do your persuasive writing. Remember to stick to your plan and refer back to it to remind and prompt you on your direction. When you are writing your text (not your plan) use the below guidelines to help you know how much writing you should have for each area.

**O:** Opinion - Paragraph (2-3 Sentences)

**R:** Reasons - 3 Reasons (2-3 Sentences each which makes 3 short paragraphs)

**E:** Explanations - 3 Explanations that link in with your reasons (2-3 sentences each which make short paragraphs)

**O:** Opinion Restated - Restate your original opinion and a brief wrap up of what you have stated

- Rules and laws should never be broken
- Every child should know how to speak another language

- watching violent television shows causes children to act violently
