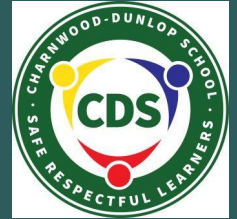

## Break Time Clubs

We have some fantastic break time clubs this term. These are great opportunities for students to have fun with our Teachers, sharing their interests in a less structured environment than in the classroom. Break time clubs run every term from week 2 to week 9. Students are welcome to turn up when they like to most clubs with a few exceptions.

Cooking group is available to all interested Year 5 and Year 6 students. There are 3 groups that run throughout the year and students choose what we cook over 5 sessions. We have a focus on making healthy, tasty and affordable food and the students really enjoy cooking and eating with their friends. This has no cost as any profit from the Fresh Tastes whole school lunches pays for this group.

Bike track is back on this term which many of our senior students really enjoy. Students ride their own or school bikes on the track during a break time. Notes to participate in this will be going home with our Year 3 students and any interested new students in Years 3 to

6. To participate in this group students must have returned their note and attend a brief training session on riding bikes safely and wearing helmets correctly. Some students have been enthusiastic about running their own clubs that are supported by staff. Tristian in Year 4 will be running paper club, and Dah Ler and Henry in Year 2 will be running Waste Warriors this term. We love their enthusiasm and hope students will enjoy their passion for creating and the environment. Supa Bricks Club is run by the Scripture Union, here students explore the bible through games. Written parental permission is required should you wish your child to join this club. Permission slips are available from the front office.
